4. Title Reciprocity Board

5. Summary/Purpose:

Abolishes the 3 -member advisory Board comprised of the Department of Motor Vehicles Commissioner, the Transportation Commissioner and the State Corporation Commission representative, which was created in 1942 to consult with the Governor on reciprocal agreements.

This Substitute empowers the Governor to enter into reciprocal agreements on behalf of the Commonwealth with any appropriate authorities of any state of the United States with respect to taxes on motor vehicles, the operation of motor vehicles, or any transaction incident to the operation of motor vehicles. This places gubernatorial authority for entering into reciprocity agreements with the Administration.
