4. Title General educational development (GED) certificate; special diploma.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill directs the Board of Education, by September 1, 2003, to develop, by regulation, requirements for the award of the general achievement diploma to students (i) passing the GED examination; (ii) successfully completing an education and training program designated by the Board; and (iii) satisfying other requirements the Board may establish. A second enactment authorizes emergency regulations.

6. Minimal Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

Fiscal implications: Costs will be incurred by the Department of Education related to the promulgation of regulations for the administration of the GED program. The cost of additional regulations should be minimal.
