4. Title General educational development (GED) certificate; special diploma.

5. Summary/Purpose: The engrossed version of this bill provides that the Board of Education establish, by regulation, requirements for the award of a general achievement diploma for those persons who have (i) achieved a passing score on the GED examination; (ii) successfully completed an education and training program designated by the Board of Education; and (iii) satisfied other requirements as may be established by the Board for the award of such diploma.

Fiscal implications: Costs will be incurred by the Department of Education related to the promulgation of regulations for the administration of the GED program. The cost of additional regulations would be minimal.
