5. Summary/Purpose: This legislation proposes to amend §§ 16.1 -278.8 and 16.1 -278.9 of the Code of Virginia by repealing the provisions requiring a deferred finding in juvenile cases of drunk driving and refusal to submit to blood or breath tests.
