The Lottery Department estimates that the revenue impact of the fee will be minimal.

- 8. Fiscalimplications: TheLottery's computersystem would require reprogramming to handle theinformation. It is estimated that the one -time cost of programming, user testing, and training, including documentation, is \$90,000. This cost can be absorbed within the current operating budget of the department. The bill provides that the Lottery may establish a reasonable fe eto process the assignments, to receive, review, and file the registration required, and to confirm compliance with the registration requirements. This fee will reflect direct and indirect costs and will be paid by the assign or/borrower.
