Legislationdirect stheSecretaryofTechnologytoreviewallinformationtechnologyprojects regardlessofhowtheprojectisfinancedandtoapproveprocurementsinexcessof\$1.0 million.ItalsorequirestheinformationprovidedbytheGovernorintheBudgetDocument toincludeascheduleanddescriptionofalldataprocessingorotherprojectsinwhichthe Commonwealthhasenteredintoorplanstoenterintoacontract,agreementorother financingagreementthatcontainsuniqueprovisions.Thebudgetsubmissionshall also includeascheduleofallterms,anticipatedduration,andcoststoallusersofallsuch contracts.

Fiscalimplications: Thebillrequiresthe ExecutiveBudgettoincludeforeachdata processingcontractorotherprojectthattheCommonwealthhasenteredintoorplanstoenter into,oraprojectthathasuniquepaymentprovisions,aprojectdescriptionandschedulethat consistsofasummaryof terms,anticipatedduration,costsorchargestoanyuser,andterms andconditionsthatbindtheCommonwealthorrestrictCommonwealthoperationsandthe methodofprocurementusedtoreachsuchterms.Tomeettherequirementofthelegislation, asigni ficantnumberofDepartmentofPlanningandBudgetstaffhourswouldbespent obtainingthisinformation,reviewingpossiblyhundredsofcurrentcontracts,summarizing theinformation,andinputtingitintoanelectronicformat.Assumingthatonepagewil libe neededpercontracttoprovidethisinformation,thiswouldresultinagreatlyexpanded BudgetDocumentandaddedprintingcosts.StaffhoursneededforreviewoftheBudget Documentcouldalsobeconsiderablyincreased.
