	The substitute version of this bill incorporates HB 1970 which was identical to HB 1627.

8.	Fiscalimplications: Thislegislation will result in minimal additional financial savings since the Department of Conservation and Recreation has already given up a position and operating support related to these boards in the recent budget reductions. Generally speaking, board expenses have been limited. This is, in part, related to the fact that many of the advisory boards have been in active, while the active one shave largely donated their time and expenses. Some of the savings will be offset by thenex ecessity for increased travel to central meeting locations of the Statewide board. If the 19 boards were to remain and become active, and if all 130 plus members choose to seek travel reimbursements, then the budget impact would be substantial. Passing fithis bill avoids that possibility.
