Summary/Purpose:**ThebillwouldexpandcoverageundertheLineofDutyActtoinclude anyemployeeoftheDe partmentofEmergencyManagementandanyemployeeofanycounty, city,ortownperformingemergencymanagementoremergencyservicesduties.Currently onlyDepartmentofEmergencyManagementhazardousmaterialsofficersarecoveredunder theLineofDuty Act.
- 6. Fiscalimpact: DPBcannotestimatethepotentialfiscalimpactassociated with this bill. The LineofDutyActprovidesforpaymentstobeneficiariesofcertaindeceasedpublicsafety officers.Iftheofficer'sdeathoccurredwhileinthelineof duty,thebeneficiaryisentitledto receive\$75,000.Iftheofficer'sdeatharoseoutofandinthecourseofhisemploymentor was within five years from his date of retirement, the beneficiary is entitled to receive ndisabledpublicsafetyofficers, theirs pouses and \$25,000.Also,undertheActcertai dependents, and beneficiaries of certain deceased publics a fety officers are entitled to receive continuedhealthinsurancecoveragefullypaidforbytheCommonwealth.DPBcannot estimate the number of individuals who would potentially be impacted by this bill. While the -timeDepartmentofEmergencyManagement billwouldcoveranadditional79full employees, it also would cover an undetermined number of wage employees, including adjunctpersonneland reservists.Inaddition,thenumberoflocalgovernmentemployeeswho wouldbecoveredunderthisbillwoulddependlargelyonthenumberandmagnitudeofany events requiring the performance of emergency management or emergency services duties, whichare notdefined in the bill.
