**4. Title** Preadmission Screening for Clients of the Woodrow Wilson Rehabilitation Center

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This bill allows a team of licensed physicians, nurses, and social workers to provide preadmission screening for clients of the Woodrow Wilson Rehabilitation Center (WWRC) for determination of need for nursing facility services. Currently, only the Department of Health or Social Services or hospitals may perform this assessment. WWRC performed this function when it was designated as a hospital, but it currently is recognized as a Comprehensive Outpatient Rehabilitation Facility and is not recognized under law to do the assessment.
