5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Currently, persons who sell fire -fighting equipment, ambulances, and funeral vehicles must be licensed by the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board. These dealers have an exemption from all other provisions of the Dealer Laws. (e.g. Minimum business hours, signs, proper zoning, etc.) This proposal would eliminate these exemptions.
