4. Title Virginia Public Procurement Act; multiphase contracts for professional

5. Summary/Purpose: The enrolled legislation permits all local public bodies to negotiate and award multiphase contracts to professional services firms for environmental, location, design, or inspection work relating to the construction of infrastructure projects based upon a price for only the first phase when completion of these earlier phases is necessary to collect information critical to the negotiation of a price for the succeeding phases. Prior to entering into any such contract, the enrolled legislation requires that the local public body state the intended total scope for the project and determine in writing that such an arrangement is in its best interests.
