VirginiaRetirementSystem; creditforservice in the armed forces. Changes there quirements under which a member may receive retirement creditforservice in the armed forces to conform to require ments under federal law. Under Virginia law, a member may receive retirement creditation cost for service in the armed forces if the member (i) was on leave of a bsence from a covered position, (ii) was not dishonorably discharged, (iii) has not with drawn his accumulated contributions, and (iv) has reentered service in a covered position within 1 year of discharge from the armed forces. However, under Virginia law , retirement creditis not granted for service in the armed forces for reen list ments that follow the cessation of host ilities. Federal law, however, provides that any service in the armed forces, when performed on a leave of absence, is eligible for retirement credit upon a person's reemployment with his employer, regardless of whether the service is in wartime.
