5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that commissions as military aides to the Gove rnorshall be issued by the Secretary of the Common wealth with the rank the Governor deems appropriate and such military aides shall serve on detail to the Governor and performs uch other duties as assigned by the Governor, including assignment to the Virg inia state defense forces. The bill also provides that the commissions of the military aides shall constitute a commission in the state militia of the Common wealth and shall entitle the recipient stothe pay and benefits of the irrank in the performance of the irduties. Currently, the second signs are honorary and do not entitle the recipient to pay or benefits.
