4. Title Special license plates; members and supporters of the YMCA of Va.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Authorizes the issuance of special license plates: members of Job's Daughters, members of the Police Benevolent Association, medical doctors, teachers, Virginia's coal mining heritage, Langley Air Force Base, supporters of the Washington Capitals hockey team, members and supporters of the YMCA of Virginia, members of the Izaak Walton League, celebrating the members and achievements of the Civilian Conservation Corps, the national motto: "In God We Trust," and multiple sclerosis.

6. No Significant Fiscal Impact

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: Only those special plates that are issued by DMV as a result of the submission of 350 or more prepaid applications will produce revenues, usually during the second year of issuance. Revenue from the first year of issuance provides for recovery of costs associated with the special plate design and development process. To date, roughly 15% of all special plate authorizations subject to the prepaid application requirements are issued.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: DMV

10. Technical amendment necessary: Yes; references to the Special Forces Association in lines 5 and 6 should be removed since that authorization (HB2708) was not incorporated into this bill.
