The sunset dates in this bill are consistent with the schedule for reviewing sales tax exemptions established under <u>Code of Virginia</u> § 30-19.05.

This bill is identical to Senate Bill 742.

House Bill 1537 would extend to July 1, 2008, the sunset date for the retail sales and use tax exemption for nonprofit tissue banks. The provisions of House Bill 1537 are included in House Bill 1754 and Senate Bill 742.

House Bill 1755 and Senate Bill 743 would extend to July 1, 2007 the sunset dates for 31 retail sales and use tax exemptions in the educational group.
