Summary/Purpose:Requiresstatebuildingsopentothepublictohavea CodeAdam programasapreventivetoolagainstchildabductionsandforlocatinglostchildrenincertain publicbuildings.Thealertsareusedtolockdownbuildingswhereachildhasbeenlostor possiblyabducted.ThebillrequirestheBoardofEduca tiontodevelop, incooperation with private entities, approgram to provide parents with child identification kits through school distribution. Thekitsshallincludeidentificationinformationaboutthesubjectchild, includingcurrentphoto, fingerprint s, DNA samples, and important medical information and shallincludeinstructionsforthepropersafekeepingofthekit.Suchkitsshallbeheldfor safekeepingbytheparent,notaschool,schoolboard,orotherpublicentity.Thebillalso establishest hevoluntaryAmberAlertProgramasameanstoprovidenoticeandinformation ofachildabductiontothepublicbythemedia(local,regionalorstatewide)tobeactivated initially in the discretion of the local law -enforcementofficials.Thisbillisi denticaltoSB 1204.

- 8. Fiscalimplications: Theproposedlegislationisnotexpectedtohaveafiscalimpactonstate agenciessinceparentswouldlikelybeobtainingchildidentificationkitsdire ctlyfromprivate entities. This legislation compliments the Governors' "KIDsafe Virginia" initiative that, by partnering with automobile dealerships statewide, has already made available 80,000 free child DNA kits for Virginia parents.

According to the Department of State Police, there would be no impact to the department resulting from this legislation. Also, the Department of General Services projects a minimal impact that could be absorbed with current funding.
