Summary/Purpose:Thebill requires that every registration statement to solicit contributions have the following statement: "Nofunds solicited by this charitable or ganization have been or will knowingly be used, directly or indirectly, to be nefitor provides upport, in cashor in kind, to terrorists, terroristor ganizations, terroristactivities, or the family members of any terrorist. "The bill prohibits the licensing or permitting of any such or ganization that has provided such support, and subjects any person who knowingly uses or permitts the use of suchfunds to be nefitor provides upport for terrorists, terrorist or ganizations, terrorist activities or family members of any terrorist, to the fines and jail time currently established. Finally, the bill subjects the assets of any person who commits or attempts to commit an act of terrorism to for feiture in accordance with \$18.2 -46.9. The bill is identical to Senate Bill 954 which is also enrolled.
