11. Othercomments: The VRS is not opposed to the phase dextension of VSDP benefits to political subdivisions. The current VSDP benefits were designed specifically to interface with the sickle avepolicies of the Common wealth. The current benefits may not interface efficiently with the unique sickle avepolicies of the various political subdivisions. In lieu of approval of this bill, VRS would recommend a study with the objective of developing a plande sign that would be more efficient given that sickle avepolicies among the various political subdivisions

are not consistent with one another and do not mirror the sick leave policies of the Common wealth.
