There are only two federally designated enterprise zones in Virginia: Ports mouth/Norfolk and Accomack/North ampton. The bill would have no fiscal impact because the Department of Housing and Community Development currently interpre ts § 59.1-275 of the <i>Code of Virginia</i> to already designate the expiration date of state enterprise zones as the same as federal zones. This bill would simply further clarify that interpretation. Therefore, the tax credits and job grants that businesses in those zones currently qualify for would not be impacted.
