4. Title Motor vehicle fees.

5. Summary/Purpose: This legislation proposes to amend §§ 46.2 -2011.6 and 46.2 -2121 of the Code of Virginia pertaining to the statutes that authorize the Department of Motor Vehicles to charge vehicle fees for passenger and property carriers. This bill modifies these statutes to clarify the purpose of motor carrier vehicle fees and identify the entities that must pay these fees.

6. No Fiscal Impact: See item #8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) advises that the passage of this proposal will have no fiscal impact on the agency, as it will only codify existing practices already required by federal regulations. The department is concerned, though, that failure to make this legislation law may negatively affect revenue receipts for the various passenger and property carrier registration programs which are partially funded from these fees because there is no Virginia statutory authority to charge the fees. This is unlikely, though, as the agency has never had Virginia statutory authority since taking over the program from the State Corporation Commission (SCC) in 1993.
