ThisproposedlegislationwouldpermittheStateHealthCommissionertoauthorize persons, nototherwiseauthorizedbylawtoadministerordispensedrugsanddevices, toadministerordispensedrugsordevicesinaccordancewithprotocolsestablished bytheCommissionerwhen1)theGovernorhasdeclaredadisasterorstateof emergencycausedb yanactofterrorismortheUnitedStatesSecretaryofHealthand HumanServiceshasissuedadeclarationofanactualorpotentialbioterrorism incidentorotheractualorpotentialpublichealthemergency,2)itisnecessaryto permittheprovisionofieededdrugsordevices,and3)suchpersonshavereceived thetrainingnecessarytosafelyadministerordispensetheneededdrugsordevices. Alldrugsanddeviceswouldbeadministeredordispensedunderthedirection, controlandsupervisionoftheCo mmissioner,usingappropriateprotocolsdeveloped bytheCommissionerinconsultationwiththeDepartmentofHealthProfessions. ThisbillisarecommendationoftheGovernor'sSecureVirginiaPanel.

8. Fiscalimplications:

The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) will be impacted by this bill to the extent that staff and resources must be redirected from daily activities to provide the training and support per the protocols established by the State Health Commission er in response to such an event. The costs associated with this activity are not determinable but are directly dependent on such variables as the type of disaster that occurs, the extent of the affected population. VDH is currently enhancing emergency response plans and building the support in frastructure to prepare for emergencies, primarily through the federal grant for such prepared nessefforts from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control.
