**5. Summary/Purpose:** Senate Bill 803 amends and reenacts § 63.2-226 and § 63.2-227 of the Code of Virginia to repeal § 63.2-223, § 63.2-224, § 63.2-225, and § 63.2-228 of the Code of Virginia, which would abolish the Human Services Information and Referral Advisory Council and its Technical Assistance Committee. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Subcommittee Studying the Operations, Practices, Duties, and Funding of the Commonwealth's Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Councils, and Other Governmental Entities pursuant to HJR 159 (2002).

**11. Other comments:** The Human Services Information and Referral Advisory Council does not currently exist. Members have not been appointed to the Council since 1998, and there have been no meetings since 1994. Since the Council is not active, no money has been budgeted to cover the cost of Council operations. Therefore, there would be no cost savings generated through the abolishment of the Council. This bill is a companion to SB 803.
