4. Title Conditional votes; identification requirement.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that a voter who is not listed on the precinct registered voter list and seeks to cast a conditional ballot must provide any one of the following forms of identification: his Commonwealth of Virginia voter registration card, his social security card, his valid Virginia driver's license, or any other identification card issued by a government agency; or any valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the voter. It shall not be sufficient for the person to sign a statement that he is the named registered voter who he claims to be, in lieu of presenting one of the listed forms of identification.

6. Minimal Fiscal Impact

8. Fiscal implications: This proposal calls for a procedural change at the local level. No fiscal impacts at the state level are anticipated to implement this change, other than the one-time expenditure of staff time necessary to inform localities of the change in procedures.
