4. Title Emergency services and disaster law; release of records

5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that the Governor or agencies acting on his behalf may receive information, voluntarily submitted from both public and nonpublic entities, related to the protection of the nation's critical infrastructure sectors and components that are located in Virginia or affect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Virginia. The bill provides that information submitted by any public or nonpublic entity in accordance with the procedures set forth in subdivision A57 of § 2.2-3705 shall not be disclosed unless it is requested by law enforcement authorities in furtherance of an official investigation or the prosecution of a criminal act; the agency holding the record is served with a proper judicial order; or the agency holding the record has obtained the written consent to release the information from the entity voluntarily submitting it.
