- **5. Summary/Purpose:** This legislation provides policychanges for the Division of Child Support Enforcement (DCSE) as follows:
 - 1. Clarifiesthatacourtmayissueashowcauseorderorcapiasforfailuretopaychildor spousalsupport,
 - 2. CodifiestheDivisionofChildSupportEnforcement'sauthoritytopu blishalistoftheten mostwanteddelinquentparents,
 - 3. AllowstheCommissioneroftheDepartmentofSocialServicestorequestandreceive informationheldbycriminaljusticeagenciesinlocatingandservingdelinquentobligors, and
 - Clarifies and protect stheauthority of the Department to place alien on personal injury and wrongful death awards, and gives priority over other liens, excluding medical and attorney fees.

- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** Yes,Item359,PublicAssistanceChildSupportCollections (46302)andNon -PublicAssistanceChildSupportCollections(46303).
- **8. Fiscalimplications:** Section 34-50fthe Code of Virginia protects spous aland child support liens, but § 34-28.10fthe Code does not specify where a child support liability would fall in relation to other creditors when personal injury and wrongful death claims are awarded. The

passageofSB1206wouldgrantstatutoryauthorityforthecourtstoallowchildsupportliens tobeplacedonpersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardsaftermedicalbillsandattorneys' feesaresatisfied. Also, the State's chil dsupportinterstatelien would bestatutorily required to behonored by another state which would assist in collecting an interstate lien.

The Department recently entered into an agreement with the Child Support Lien Network (CSLN) whose objective ist operform data matching to increase support collections through interception of insurance claims ettlements before they are sent to a claim ant who owe spast due child support. This bill would assist in increasing the amount of collections DCSE will receive from the CSLN, eliminate litigation over whether we can claim these proceeds, and give the insurance industry some comfort knowing that DCSE can legally attach these personal in jury and wrongful death proceeds.

InFY2002,DCSEcollected\$104,348,616in childsupportpaymentsfrom16,476liensthat wereinplace.WiththepassageofSB1206,itisestimatedthattheamountofcollections frompersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardswouldincreasecollectionsapproximately \$3.1million(\$104,348,616* 3percent).AllcollectionsareincludedinDCSE'srevenueand allpaymentspassthroughtothecustodialparent.
