Fiscalimplications:** Section 34-5 of the Code of Virginia protects spous al andchildsupport liens,but§34 -28.1oftheCodedoesnotspecifywhereachildsupportliabilitywouldfallin relationtoothercreditorswhenpersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathclaimsareawarded. The passageofSB1206wouldgrantstatutoryauthorit yforthecourtstoallowchildsupportliens

tobeplacedonpersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardsaftermedicalbillsandattorneys' feesaresatisfied. Also, the State's childsupport interstatelien would be statutorily required to behonored by another state which would assist in collecting an interstate lien.

The Department recently entered into an agreement with the Child Support Lien Network (CSLN) whose objective is to perform data matching to increase support collections through interception of insurance claims ettlements before they are sent to a claim antwhoo we spast due child support. This bill would assist in increasing the amount of collections DCSE will receive from the CSLN, eliminate litigation overwhether the department can clai mthese proceeds, and give the insurance in dustry some comfort knowing that DCSE can legally attach these personal injury and wrongful death proceeds.

InFY2002,DCSEcollected\$104,348,616inchildsupportpaymentsfrom16,476liensthat wereinplace. WiththepassageofSB1206,itisestimatedthattheamountofcollections frompersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardswouldincreasecollectionsapproximately \$3.1million(\$104,348,616*3percent).AllcollectionsareincludedinDCSE'srevenuean allpaymentspassthroughtothecustodialparent.
