Fiscalimplications: Section34- 5oftheCodeofVirginiaprotectsspousalandchildsupport liens,but§34 -28.1ofth eCodedoesnotspecifywhereachildsupportliabilitywouldfallin relationtoothercreditorswhenpersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathclaimsareawarded.The passageofSB1206wouldgrantstatutoryauthorityforthecourtstoallowchildsupportlien tobeplacedonpersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardsaftermedicalbillsandattorneys'

feesaresatisfied.Also,theState'schildsupportinterstatelienwouldbestatutorilyrequired tobehonoredbyanotherstatewhichwouldassistincollectin ganinterstatelien.

TheDepartmentrecentlyenteredintoanagreementwiththeChildSupportLienNetwork (CSLN)whoseobjectiveistoperformdatamatchingtoincreasesupportcollectionsthrough interceptionofinsuranceclaimsettlementsbeforethe yaresenttoaclaimantwhoowespast duechildsupport.ThisbillwouldassistinincreasingtheamountofcollectionsDCSEwill receivefromtheCSLN,eliminatelitigationoverwhetherwecanclaimtheseproceeds,and givetheinsuranceindustrysomec omfortknowingthatDCSEcanlegallyattachthese personalinjuryandwrongfuldeathproceeds.

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InFY2002,DCSEcollected\$104,348,616inchildsupportpaymentsfrom16,476liensthat wereinplace.WiththepassageofSB1206,itisestimatedthatthea mountofcollections frompersonalinjuryandwrongfuldeathawardswouldincreasecollectionsapproximately \$3.1million(\$104,348,616*3percent).AllcollectionsareincludedinDCSE'srevenueand allpaymentspassthroughtothecustodialparent.
