**4. Title** VirginiaWarOrphansEducationAct.

5. Summary/Purpose: This billentitled the "Virginia WarOrphans Edu cation Act", adds the children of parents who are killed or disable dasare sult of service in military operations against terrorism, appeare -keeping mission, or a terrorist acts ubsequent to December 6, 1941, to the list of children eligible to attend pub licinstitutions of highered ucation or other accredited postse condary institutions granting acertificate, diploma, or degree, free of tuition and required fees. In addition, the bill clarifies that the children of members of the United States Armed Serv ices Reserves and the Virginia National Guard Reserve called to active military duty and who are killed in action or are totally and permanently disable dareal so eligible for such benefits.

Thisbillalsomakesthebenefitsconsistentbetweeneligible childrenofmembersofthe militaryandeligiblechildrenandspousesofpersonswhoarekilledinthelineofdutywhile employedorservingaslaw -enforcementofficers,firefighters,correctionalofficers,localand regionaljailfarmsuperintendents,s heriffs,deputysheriffs,andemergencymedicalservices. Further,thisbillprovidestechnicalamendmentstoclarifyforwhomtuitionandrequiredfees arewaived.

Fiscalimplications: Previouslawprovidedforfreetuition, coverageofinstitutional charges and required fees, and books and supplies for those children of parents who were killed in action, we remissing inaction, we reaprisoner of war, we reorbeca metotally and permanently disabled in any armed conflict subsequent to December 6, 1941. This bill incorporates anewpopulation of those children whose parent was involved in military operations against terror is morapeace keeping mission or because of a terror is tattack. It is unclear how many students this new legislation would include and thus making the total cost tuition and fees would be waived as part of the seproposed changes undeterminable.

Onecouldconcludethattherewouldbeaminorfisca limpactbeyondtheforegonetuition andfeestopublicinstitutionsofhighereducationintheCommonwealthsincethisbill requireseachinstitutiontoincludeastatementdescribingthebenefitsprovidedinthisbillin

allcatalogsorequivalentpublic ations. The billspecifically prohibits the Department of Veterans Affairs from receiving any compensation because of performing the determination of eligibility services.
