5. Summary/Purpose: Thisbillauthorizesthe VirginiaPublicSchoolAuthority(VPSA)to issuebondstofundgrantstolocalschooldivisionsinthetotalamountof\$1billiontopay thecostsofschoolconstruction, schoolrenovation, and otherschoolinfrastructureproje cts (tobeissuednolaterthanJanuary1,2010). The schedule for the issuance of the bonds and the payment of the debtservice on them shall be asprovided in the general appropriation act. One-half of the grants(\$500 million) shall be distributed to e ach school division in an equal amount of \$3,676,471. The remaining one -half shall be distributed to each local school division on a set perpupilamount based on each school division's actual September 30,2002, fall membership data as a proportion of to talactual September 30,2002, fall membership data for all school divisions. In implementing this bill, the Virginia Public School Authority shall not incurmore than atotal of \$250 million in debtinany fiscal year.

Suchgrantsshallnotbeusedto calculateorreducetheshareoffederal,state,orlocal revenuesorfundsotherwiseavailabletolocalgovernments,schoolboards,orschool divisions,norshalltheybeusedtocalculateorreduceanyallocationofrevenuesorfunds including,butnot limitedto,statebasicaidpayments.

TheBoardofEducationshalldeterminethepriorityforthepaymentsofthegrantstoeach localschooldivision.WrittencertificationmustbeprovidedtothechairmanoftheVPSA directinghimtomakegrantpayment sinaspecificamounttoaschooldivision.TheVPSA shallmakethegrantpaymentwithin30daysofreceipt.

Inaddition, the Board of Education shall is sueguidelines for the priority of the grant payments. Guidelines shall provide that grants be paid based upon: (1) then eed for the public school project in comparison to then eed for public school projects in other school divisions; (2) there addiness of the project for construction, building, or completion; and (3) the VPS A having sufficient funds on hand to make such grant payments. The guidelines shall also include: (1) provisions which address approval by the local governing body of the construction, addition, or site acquisition for which grant moneys are sought by a local school division; (2) the applications for a grant by a local school division pursuant to this act; and (3) the implementation of the procedure for disbursing grant stolocal school divisions.

Finally, beginning in 2004, the Board of Education shall make an annual report to th General Assembly on June 1 of each year.

8. Fiscalimplications: Theproposedlegislationdoesnotdesignateafundsourceforthedebt service. Therefore, it is assumed that the general fund would be used to fund this program. The estimated annual cost of debts ervice (assuming \$250 million per year at 5.1 per cent over 20 years) is \$20.6 million per issuance. An ewgeneral fund appropriation for rdebts ervice may be needed during the 2002 -2004 biennium depending on when the debt is issued. Also, these bonds would represent tax support eddebt of the Common wealth, which would have a negative impact on debt capacity. An amendment is needed for an ewItem 293.1 to establish the issuances chedule, identify the funding source and appropriate amounts for debt service.

In order to implement the provisions of this bill, the Department of Education would need on ead ditional position, beginning in FY 2004 . The salary and benefit cost of this position is estimated at \$70,000. (Amendment to Item 137.)

TheDepartmentofTreasurywouldneedtwoadditionalpositionstoestablishandoperatethis program,beginninginFY2004.Onepositionwouldbeneededin theDebtDivisionandone inthedepartment'sTrustAccountingDivision.Thesalary,benefits,andstartupcostsforthe Treasurypositionsareestimatedat\$127,000.(AmendmenttoItem290.)
