Thisamendedlegislationm ovesthestaffresponsibilityfortheAlzheimer'sDiseaseand RelatedDisordersCommission(Commission)fromtheDepartmentofMentalHealth,Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to the Virginia Department for the Aging (the Department). The Commissionis reconstituted with an additional member bringing the numberto 15 and providing for both gubernatorial and legislative appointees. It sexpanded duties included eveloping a plan formeeting the needs of patients with Alzheimer's disease andrel ateddisordersandtheircaregivers, submitting an annual report to the Governor and General Assembly and making application for and expending grants, gifts or bequests. The billchargestheDepartmentwithprovidingreferralsthatlinkfamiliescaringfo Alzheimer'sdiseaseandrelateddisorderswithVirginia'schaptersoftheAlzheimer'sDisease and Related Disorders Association. The Departmental somust provide information, counseling, and referral about services and programs that may sup portindividualsand families dealing with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders. Finally, the bill moves and renamestheexistingAlzheimer'sandRelatedDiseasesResearchAwardFundtothisnewly createdarticle.

Fiscalimplications: Duringtheearly1990s,legislationwaspassedthatrequiredthe Alzheimer'sCommissiontoserv einadvisorycapacitytotheSecretaryofHealthandHuman ResourcesratherthantheDepartmentofMentalHealth,MentalRetardationandSubstance AbuseServices(DMHMRSAS).However,thestatutoryestablishmentoftheAlzheimer's Commissionremainswithi nthesectionoftheVirginiacoderelatedtoDMHMRSAS.This year'slegislationwouldmovetheauthorityoutoftheDMHMRSASsectionofthecodeand specificallyplaceitwithintheVirginiaDepartmentfortheAging(VDA).Inpracticality, VDAstaffsthe Commission,butDMHMRSAShascontinuedtofinanciallysupportthe Commissionbyproviding\$5,000peryeartoVDA.Thisbudgetactionwouldpermanently placeDMHMRSAS'sfinancialsupportof\$5,000fortheAlzheimer'sCommissionwithin theDepartmentofAg ingandeliminatetheneedforyearlytransfers.
