5. Summary/Purpose:

Theproposed bill would expand the list of state and local employees defined as law enforcement of ficers to include conservation of ficers of the Department of Conservation and Recreation.

Undercurrentlaw,anylawenforcementofficermustcomplywithminimumtraining standardsdevelopedbytheDepartmentofCriminalJusticeServices .However,thebillwould exemptanyconservationofficersappointedpriortoJuly1,2003fromthisrequirement.

8. Fiscalimplications:

Thereareseveralcriminal statutespertainingtolawenforcementofficers.Mostofthese provisionsimposeenhancedpenaltiesfortheassaultormurderofalawenforcementofficer. Forexample,asimpleassaultofacivilianisaClass1misdemeanorpunishablebyupto12 months injail,whereasasimpleassaultofalawenforcementofficerisaClass6felony, punishablebyupto12monthsinjailoronetofiveyearsinprison.Byexpandingthe definitionoflawenforcementofficer,theproposedbillcouldthereforeresultinad ditional personsinjailorprison.

Thereisnotenoughinformationavailabletoreliablyestimatehowmanyadditionalinmates injailcouldresultfromthisproposal.Anyincreaseinjailpopulationwillincreasecoststo thestate.TheCommonwealthp aysthelocalities\$8.00adayforeachmisdemeanantor otherwiselocalresponsibleprisonerheldinajail,\$8.00adayforeachstateresponsible inmateheldforsixtydaysorless,and\$14.00adayforeachstateresponsibleinmateheldfor morethansi xtydays.Italsofundsmostofthejails'operatingcosts,e.g.correctionalofficers. Thestate'sshareofthesecostsonaperprisoner,perdaybasisvariesfromlocalitytolocality. However,accordingtotheCompensationBoard,theestimatedtotal statesupportforlocal jailsaveraged\$31.86perinmate,perdayinFY2001. Duetothelackofdata,theVirginiaCriminalSentencingCommissionhasdetermined, pursuantto§30 -19.1:4oftheCodeofVirginia,thattheimpactoftheproposedlegislation state-responsible(prison)bedspacecannotbedetermined.However,itisexpectedthatthe impactwillbenegligible.

TheDepartmentofConservationandRecreationalreadycomplieswiththeDCJSlaw enforcementofficertrainingstandardsforitsc onservationofficersandthusthebillwouldnot haveafiscalimpactontheagency.Becausetheconservationofficerswouldbecoveredby existinglawenforcementofficerstandards,thebillwouldnothaveafiscalimpactonthe DepartmentofCriminalJu sticeServices.
