The State Corporation Commission is empowered to order a call blocked to any telephone number used in connection with such transmissions. Enforcement provision sunder the Consumer Protection Act (i) permit the Attorney General to is succivil investigati ve demands and assurances of voluntary compliance, (ii) create an individual action for damages, and (iii) permit aggrieved parties or the Attorney General to seek in junctive relief to prevent further violations.
