8. Fiscalimplications:

For some one convicted of a Class of elony, a jud gehas the option of sentencing him to up to one year in jail, or 1 to 5 years in prison. Anyone convicted of a Class 1 mis demeanor is subject to a sentence of up to 12 months in jail. Therefore, this proposal could result in an increase in the number of persons sentenced to jail or prison.

Thereisnotenoughinformationavailabletoreliablyestimatehowmanyadditional inmatesinjailcouldresultfromthisproposal. Anyincreaseinjailpopulationwillincrease coststothestate. The Commonweal thpaysthelocalities \$8.00 aday for each misdemean ant or otherwise local responsible prisoner heldinajail. It also funds most of the jails' operating costs, e.g. correctional officers. The state's share of the secosts on a perprisoner, perday basis varies from locality to locality. However, according to the Compensation Board, the estimated to talstate support for local jails averaged \$31.86 per inmate, perday in FY2001.

The Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission has determined, pursuant to \$30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, that, based on the recent history of sentences for offenses related to dog fighting, the proposed legislation is not likely to have an impact on state -responsible (prison) bedspace.
