**4. Title** Personal injury claims; Commonwealth's lien.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This bill adds nursing homes to the medical service providers that have a lien on an injured person's personal injury claim. In addition, the bill provides that the negligent party is liable for the cost of any health care provided to the injured party at the time of and subsequent to the events giving rise to the personal injury claim. The lien for amounts paid to the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) may not be reduced and apportioned by the court by more than 10 percent.
