5.	Summary/Purpose: The bill creates the Nonindigenous Aquatic Nuisance Species Act within the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. This bill declares the zebramus seland northerns nake head fishas nonindigenous aquatic nuisance species. This bill authorizes the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to declare other nonindigenous aquatic nuisance species if it finds that the presence of such nonindigenous aquatic species in state water sposes or is likely to pose a significant threat of harm. The bill authorizes the department to take measures to suppress, control, eradicate, preventor retard the spread of any nonindigenous aquatic species. It also provides for a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 for any person that violates the provisions of the Act, and provides that such person is also liable for the costs of investigation, control and eradication in curred by a state agency or local government.

8.	Fiscalimplications: The bill provides that the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries may promulgate regulations, which will result in some minor costs related to staff time. It also provides that the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries may conduct operations to controlore radicate nonindigenous aquatic species. This will impose a fiscal impact on the agency. However, while a minor one -time situation that involves the eradication of aspecies in asmall lake may have only minor costs, a major out break of infestation of an uisance species throughout the waters of the Common wealth would have a significant fiscal impact on the agency, which cannot be absorbed. Considering that such events are impossible to predict and the reis no funding source designated for this bill, the find a scalim pact cannot be determined.
