5.	Summary/Purpose: The bill creates the Nonindigenous Aquatic Nuisance Species Act within the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. This bill declares the zebramussel, quaggamussel, and all species of snakehead fishes of family Channidae as nonindigenous aquatic nuisance species. This bill authorizes the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to declare other nonindigenous aquatic nuisance species if it finds that the presence of such nonindigenous aquatic species in state water sposes or is likely to pose a signific ant threat of harm.	
	The bill authorizes the department to take measures to suppress, control, eradical retard the spread of any nonindigenous aquatic species. It also provides that the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries may conduct operations to control or eradicate nonindigenous aquatics pecies subject to appropriation of general funds authorized for such purpose. Therefore, any fiscal impact on the department because of a minor situation that involves the eradication of aspecies in a small lake or a major out break of infestation of an uisance species throughout the waters of the Commonwealth would be subject to appropriation. Considering that such events are impossible to predict, no future fiscal impact can be eletermined.
