**4. Title** Corrections; payment of costs by local inmates.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Allows local sheriffs and jail superintendents to charge each inmate in their facility a fee of \$1 per day to defray the costs of his keep. This fee would be in addition to any other fee or costs imposed upon the inmate. These funds would stay with the locality where collected to be used for general jail purposes. The Board of Corrections would develop a model plan and adopt regulations to govern such a program.

**8. Fiscal implications:** According to the Compensation Board, the proposed legislation would not have a fiscal impact since any fees collected by sheriffs and jail administrators would stay with the locality to be used solely for jail expenses.
