Trichloroethylene prohibited; penalty. Add trichloroethylene (TCE) to the list of hazardous household chemicals regulated by the Department of Environmental Quality and prohibits the use or sale of any household product containing TCE as of January 1, 2004. Violations are Class 3 misdemeanors.
