## 5. Summary/Purpose:

Thisbillwouldr equireafinancialandmanagementauditofallstateagencies, independent agencies, and all instrumentalities except localities, by private auditing firms, to improve governmental efficiency. The audits hould be completed by November 30,2003 and finding reviewed by a joint subcommittee of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees. The joint subcommittees hould make recommendation sto improve the efficiency of each agency by December 31,2003.

- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** None; billwould specify that agencies are to pay for these audits out of existing budgets.
- **8.** Fiscalimplications: Fiscalimpactis based on estimates. This legislation applies to all state agencies, independen tagencies, and instrumentalities excluding localities. It appears that this billwouldapplyonlytostateagencies, independent agencies, stateboards, and commissions, and not to any nonstate agency or regional authority. Expenditure impact estimate f orFY03 and FY04 is based on requirement that all initial audits be completed during the biennium, and that half are conducted each year. Costs based on average fees charged by auditing/consulting firms currently doing business with the Commonwealth for s taff, senior, supervisory, manager, and partner hours, weighted by average involvement of each level. Costestimate further assumes an average of 750 hours per agency per audit, recognizing that there is a high variance for larger and smaller agencies. 1 81 agencies, commissions, and boards were tallied and used in the computation. Based on these assumptions, annual expenditures of approximately \$9.1 million for each year of the 2002 -2004 biennium would berequiredfromeachagencyoutofexistingbudgete dfunds.
