Fiscalimplications:ThebillgivestheStateBoardofElections(SBE)theflexibilitytouse outsideexpertisetomeetthe60daytimelimitforeachofthereviews.Theelectioncyclesare suchthatbetween40and50reviewswouldneedtobecompletedforeachelect ioncycle.The electioncyclesvary,everyfouryearsallofthestatewideofficesandtheHouseofDelegates areupforelection.TheSBEestimatesthatasmanyas20campaigncommitteesforstatewide officeswouldneedtobereviewedandtenpercentof theestimated270housecampaign committees27reviews.Followedintwoyearsbythenextcycle,whereall140membersof theGeneralAssemblyareupforelection.SBEestimatesthatasmanyas380campaign committeescouldbesubjecttothetenperce ntreviewrequirementor38reviews.

Thesecondcycle, for all members of the General Assembly, uses the same \$2,500 perreview with the number of reviews assumed to be ten percent of 380 or 38. The total cost for this cyclewould be about \$95,000.

Fundingwouldbenecessaryinthesecondyearofeachbienniumstar tingwiththe 2004 - 06 biennium. The first election subject to this provision would be the next election for all Statewide of ficers and the House of Delegates in November of 2005.
