EstablishesanexemptionfromcertainprovisionsoftheAdministrativeProcessActfor agencyregulationsdeterminedtobenoncontroversial. The process requires approval by the Governor. In addition, if the reisano bjection to the use of the fast track process from 10 or more persons, anymember of the applicable standing committee of either house of the General Assembly, or anymember of the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules, the agency is required to use the standard APA promulgation process. This legisla tion is a recommendation of the Virginia Code Commission.
