5. Summary/Purpose:

Recodifiesseveralsec tionsoftheCoderelatingtogeneralprocedurespursuanttoexercisingthepower ofeminentdomain.Title25hasnotbeenrecodifiedsincetheadoptionoftheCodeofVirginiaof1950. SectionsoftheCodehavebeenchangedtoclarifyprovisionsandtoe liminateunnecessarylanguage. Additionally,certainsubstantivechangesweremade,whichshouldreflectcurrentpracticesoreliminate inconsistenciesbetweenprovisions.Sectionsthatwerechangedincludethefollowing:general provisionsapplicableto theentiretitle,includingcertaindefinitions;generaleminentdomainprocedures; "quick take"procedures;provisionsthatreflectthefederalUniformRelocationAssistanceandReal PropertyAcquisitionsPoliciesActof1972;andtheacquisitionofwate rworkssystemsbylocal governments.
