4. Title Department of General Services, Division of Purchases and Supply; dire

5. Summary/Purpose: This proposal allows organizations providing transportation services in Virginia that receive funding from either the Federal Transit Administration or the Commonwealth Transportation Fund to purchase directly from the contracts established by the Division of Purchases and Supply. The Department of Rail and Public Transportation is to assist the Division of Purchases and Supply in establishing and maintaining a list of organizations authorized to make such purchases.

6. Fiscal Impact is INDETERMINATE

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The fiscal implications of this proposal are indeterminate. Although the measure primarily benefits transportation services organizations, it could provide a benefit to all state agencies that purchase goods and services from contracts established by the Department of General Services' Division of Purchases and Supply. If the division's staff were able to factor additional purchase volumes into the contracts they establish for these goods and services, these additional purchase volumes could translate into lower costs for the affected goods and services. This would in turn assist any other agencies purchasing these items off the division's contracts.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: This proposal affects the Department of General Services and the Department of Rail and Public Transportation.

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: The Department of Rail and Public Transportation already possesses a list of these transportation services organizations for the Division of Purchases and Supply's use.
