In addition, the fiscalimpact infuture bienniais unknown as its contingent on the rebasing of the Standards of Quality model. It is, however, noteworthy that the original bill did have a fiscalimpact of \$300,827 in FY 2004. This impact assumed that the provisions of this bill would affect Highland County, which is a division with 350 students or fewer in averaged ailymembership. Moreover, it assumed that Highland County would enter into a service -sharing agreement with a county would receive a basic aidentitlement using Augusta County's composite index.
