Juvenilecriminalrecords. Authorizesth ereleaseofjuvenileinformationin the Central Criminal Records Exchange (CCRE) to authorize dofficers or employees of criminal justice agencies for purposes of the administration of criminal justice. Under the Code, finger prints and disposition must be forwarded to CCRE for a juvenile of any age found guilty of a felony, misdemean or sunder Title 54.1, and misdemean or spunishable by confinement in jail except for trespassing, DUI and disorderly conduct. However, finger prints are only required to be taken for juvenile saged 14 and older charged with a violent juvenile felony. Taking finger prints for other charges is discretionary by law -enforcement.
