**4. Title**           Financial responsibility of sheriffs and localities for medical treatment of inmates.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Clarifies that a sheriff, jail superintendent or a locality is not required to pay for the medical treatment of an inmate for an injury, illness, or condition that existed prior to the inmate's commitment to a local or regional facility.

**8. Fiscal implications:** According to the Compensation Board, the proposed legislation would not have a fiscal impact since the legislation reflects what is currently practiced at local and regional jails. The Department of Corrections' jail standards requires local and regional jails to address the handling of these medical conditions in its medical cost-pay policy.
