Fiscalimplications: TheDepartmentofEnvironmentalQ uality'sFY2004budgetincludes anadditional\$850,000to developastatewidewatersupplyplanninginitiativeandtosponsor groundwaterresearch.Ofthatamount,theDepartmentofEnvironmentalQualityestimates that\$621,088willbeneededtoestablis hacomprehensivewatersupplyplanningprocessfor thedevelopmentoflocal,regionalandstatewatersupplyplans.Theremainingfunds (\$228,912)willbeusedtoinstalladditionalwatergaugesandtodeveloptheUnitedStates GeologicalSurvey/Departme ntofEnvironmentalQualityCoastalPlainModel.

The agency estimates that this funding (\$850,000), if it is maintained permanently in its budget, would be sufficient to implement the provisions of this bill. The agency estimates, however, that it would need an additional 10 positions (general fund) to implement these provisions.
