Fiscalimplications:** Otherthantheauthorizationforthe SpecialForcesAssociation, only thosespecialplatesthatare issuedbyDMVasaresultofthesubmissionof350ormore prepaidapplicationswillproducerevenues, usually during these condyear of issuance. Revenues from the first year of issuance provide for recovery of costs associated with the special platedes ignanded velopment process. To date, roughly 15% of all special plate authorizations subject to the prepaid application requirements are issued.

Asforthe SpecialForcesAssociationauthorization, payment of the one -time\$3,500, less the \$10 annualiss uance fees submitted with the prepaid applications received, will ensure the costs associated with the design and development process are recovered prior to the issuance of the seplates. If the minimum number of prepaid applications required by the bill (50) are submitted, revenue would total \$500 for FY04. Since the number of members of the association is very limited, revenues are not ever expected to be significantly higher than \$500 in any given year once the plates are is sued.
