5. Summary/Purpose: This bill authorizes law enforcement officers to use computer voice stress analyzers to detect the truth of statements. "Law enforcement officer" is defined as any full-time employee of a police department or sheriff's office that is a part of or administered by the Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof, and who is responsible for the prevention and detection of crime and the enforcement of the penal, traffic or highway laws of the Commonwealth.
