**4. Title** Administration; records on gubernatorial appointees.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Requires the Secretary of the Commonwealth to maintain and transfer to the Governor -elect certain records on collegial bodies to which the Governor makes appointments and their members. The Secretary is required to keep records regarding contact information on the chairman, vice chairman and other current appointees and the staff to the collegial body. The databases shall also list statutory provisions on terms and eligibility criteria. Agencies providing staff support to collegial bodies shall provide the Secretary of the Commonwealth with any changes in contact information.

**8. Fiscal implications:** The Secretary of the Commonwealth has indicated that passage of this legislation would require no additional resources.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** The Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth and any agencies or entities of the Commonwealth that provide staff support to any collegial bodies to which the Governor makes appointments.
